

ORDINANCE 604

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PARTICIPATION OF DELAWARE TOWNSHIP
IN THE PIKE COUNTY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

604.1 DEFINITIONS

Definitions of words in this Ordinance are listed alphabetically in the Definitions Dictionary located at the beginning of the combined Ordinances of Delaware Township. These definitions are an integral part of the Ordinances of Delaware Township, which are incomplete without them.

604.2 PURPOSES

Local municipalities in Pike County have determined to create an intergovernmental organization to be known as the Pike County Council of Governments (the COG), the purposes of which are to identify, discuss, and solve mutual problems, and to develop cooperative approaches to the provision of municipal services. The Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Law (Act of July 12, 1972, P.L. 762, No. 180) authorizes municipal governments to cooperate by means of joint agreements, and Section 7 of said Act requires that municipalities entering into such an agreement to adopt an ordinance to that effect. The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize Delaware Township's participation in the Pike County Council of Governments.

604.3 DURATION OF PARTICIPATION

Delaware Township shall participate in the COG until this Ordinance is repealed.

604.4 MEMBERSHIP

One member shall be appointed by each participating municipal governing body, which member shall be an elected or appointed member of the governing body and shall serve at its pleasure.

604.5 BY-LAWS

The COG shall adopt By-Laws to provide for its organization and operation, which By-Laws shall be approved by each governing body before becoming binding on it.

604.6 FINANCING AND OPERATION

The COG shall develop and adopt a method of financing its operations. It shall be empowered to receive and expend funds, to enter into contracts, to hire employees, and to take other actions necessary to fulfill the purposes set forth above (604.2).

604.7 PROPERTY

The COG shall adopt procedures for the acquisition, management, and disposal of both real and personal property.

604.8 JOINT MUNICIPAL SERVICES

The provision of municipal services on a joint basis with other members of the COG shall require the execution of agreements separate from this Ordinance.

604.9 ENACTMENT

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.


