

ORDINANCE NO 614-2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 614-1991, ENTITLED ESTABLISHING A RECREATION COMMISSION, ON JUNE 20, 1991.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S 66506, entitled "General Powers", Board of Supervisors is authorized to make and adopt Ordinances necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Township, and the maintenance of the health and welfare of the Township and its citizens;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. 66601, the Board of Supervisors may adopt or repeal Ordinances in which general or specific powers of the Township may be exercised, and, by the enactment of subsequent Ordnances, the Board of Supervisors may amend, repeal or revise existing Ordinances and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township ordained and enacted Ordinance No. 614-1991, on June 20, 1991, entitled Establishing a Recreation Commission, be repealed; and;

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township that Ordinance No. 614-1991 enacted on June 20, 1991 be repealed.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, to wit:

1. Ordinance No.614-1991 entitled Establishing a Recreation Commission is hereby repealed.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect five days of its enactment.
